2nd row - 1. Fragments of angels and texts from the Te Deum, 2. The old pries Simeon received Jesus in the Temple, 3. Jesus with the Teachers in the Temple, 4. The Wedding Feast at Cana, 5. A mixture of jumbled fragments, including the mitred head of St Gregory, with a dove at his ear.

3rd row - 1. Female figure, thought to be St Mary Magdalen, made up of fragments, set in more fragments, including Herling baskets. 2. The Betrayal of Jesus, 3. The Crucifixion, 4. The Body of Jesus in the arms of his weeping Mother, 5. Five angels bear Mary into heaven.

4th row - Sir Robert Wingfield, 2. The Resurrection, 3. The Ascension, 4. The Coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, 5. Sir William Chamberlain.
